PROGRAMME THREE

PRIMARY SPORTS LEADERSHIP

Our Primary Sports Leadership awards have been designed to use sport and physical activity to help young people develop and improve their leadership skills. The award also aims to improve selfconfidence and behaviour through responsibility.

Primary Leaders will learn and demonstrate important life skills such as effective communication and organisation whilst learning to lead basic physical activities to their peers.

- The programme is aimed at Year 5/6 Pupils.
- The programme run for 5 x 1 hour sessions. (These sessions can be during curriculum time or as an after school club)
- To complete the course the group will required to lead one of the Featherstone SSP competitions or festivals
- Each Primary Sports Leader will be issued with a Sports Leader Certificate and one child will be select to receive the 'Star Leader' Trophy.
